BATON ROUGE, La. — Secretary of State Kyle Ardoin addressed the order granting a stay by the United States Supreme Court in *Ardoin v. Robinson*, allowing the congressional district maps enacted by the Louisiana Legislature to be used in the fall 2022 elections.
