Chaneyville Fire Protection District No. 7 Proposition

Summary: Levy and collection of 10.0 mills property tax within the Chaneyville Fire Protection District No. 7, Parish of East Baton Rouge, State of Louisiana, beginning with the tax collection for the year 2012, and annually thereafter, to and including the year 2021, for the purpose of providing funds to be used by the Chaneyville Fire Protection District No. 7 to acquire, construct, improve, maintain and/or operate facilities and equipment to provide fire protection services in and for the Chaneyville Fire Protection District No. 7, including the purchase of fire trucks and fire fighting equipment, and to pay the costs of obtaining water for fire protection purposes, including hydrant rentals and service.

Shall the Chaneyville Fire Protection District No. 7, Parish of East Baton Rouge, State of Louisiana (the "District"), under the provisions of Article VI, Section 19 of the 1974 Louisiana Constitution, Section 1501.(A)(1) of Title 40 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended (La. R.S. 40:1501.(A)(1)), and other constitutional and statutory authority supplemental thereto, be authorized to levy and collect, and adopt an ordinance providing for such levy and collection, of a special ad valorem tax of 10.0 mills on the dollar of assessed valuation on all property subject to taxation with the boundaries of the District (the "Tax") (an estimated \$60,000 is reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the Tax for the entire year), beginning with the tax collection for the year 2012, and annually thereafter, to and including the year 2021, and shall the proceeds of said Tax (after paying the reasonable and necessary expenses of collecting and administering the Tax) be used by the District to acquire, construct, improve, maintain and/or operate facilities and equipment to provide fire protection services in and for the District, including the purchase of fire trucks and other fire fighting equipment, and to pay the costs of obtaining water for fire protection purposes, including hydrant rentals and service?
