Fire District No. 6 Proposition  
(Bond)

Summary: To authorize not exceeding \$1,300,000 of not exceeding 20 year General Obligation Bonds of Fire Protection District No. 6 for the purpose of acquiring, constructing and improving buildings, machinery and equipment, including fire trucks, to be used in giving fire protection to the property in the District, title to which shall be in the public, said bonds to be payable from ad valorem taxes.

Shall Fire Protection District No. 6 of the Parish of Lafourche, State of Louisiana (the "District"), incur debt and issue bonds to the amount of not exceeding One Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,300,000), to run not exceeding twenty (20) years from date thereof, with interest at a rate not exceeding eight per centum (8%) per annum, to be sold at par, premium or discount, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing and improving buildings, machinery and equipment, including fire trucks, to be used in giving fire protection to the property in the District, title to which shall be in the public; which bonds will be general obligations of the District and will be payable from ad valorem taxes to be levied and collected in the manner provided by Article VI, Section 33 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, and statutory authority supplemental thereto, with an estimated increase of two and forty hundredths mills (2.40) to be levied in the first year of issue above the 1.00 mill currently being levied to pay General Obligation Bonds of the District?
