Pressburg East Neighborhood Improvement and Security District Proposition

Summary: The levy of a special annual fee in the amount of two hundred dollars (\$200) for four (4) years upon each parcel of real property in the Pressburg East Neighborhood Improvement and Security District for the primary object and purpose of promoting and encouraging the beautification, security and overall betterment of the Pressburg East Neighborhood Improvement and Security District.

Shall the City of New Orleans levy a special annual fee, to be called the Pressburg East Neighborhood Improvement and Security District's fee, on each parcel of real property situated within the boundaries of Pressburg East Neighborhood Improvement and Security District (which District is comprised of that area of the Parish of Orleans whose boundaries are coterminous with the boundaries of the Pressburg East Neighborhood Improvement and Security District) as specified by Resolution R-11-404 of the City Council of New Orleans in the amount of two hundred dollars (\$200) annually for four (4) years, beginning in 2012 and ending in 2015, with an estimated \$210,000 expected annually to be collected from the levy of the parcel fee for the entire year, to be used solely and exclusively for the primary object and purpose of promoting and encouraging the beautification, security and overall betterment of the Pressburg East Neighborhood Improvement and Security District, as determined and managed by the Board of Commissioners of the Pressburg East Neighborhood Improvement and Security District which security shall be supplemental to and not in lieu of personnel and services provided in the Pressburg East Neighborhood Improvement and Security District by the New Orleans Police Department?
