Law Enforcement District Proposition
(Sales Tax Renewal)

Summary: A one percent (1%) sales and use tax renewal to fund salaries and related benefits for employees of the Grant Parish Sheriff, and to fund the acquisition, lease, operation and maintenance of vehicles, furniture, fixtures and equipment for the Grant Parish Sheriff's Office.

Shall the Law Enforcement District of the Parish of Grant, State of Louisiana (the "District"), be authorized to continue to levy and collect a tax of one percent (1%) (the "Tax") upon the sale at retail, the use, the lease or rental, the consumption, and the storage for use or consumption, of tangible personal property and on sales of services in the District, all as defined by law (an estimated \$971,000 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the tax for an entire year) from and after the termination of its current authorization (December 31, 2009), said Tax having been previously authorized at elections held on October 2, 1994, July 18, 1998 and April 17, 2004, with the avails or proceeds of said Tax (after paying the reasonable and necessary costs and expenses of administering and collecting the Tax) being dedicated and expended for the purpose of (1) paying salaries and related benefits to employees of the Grant Parish Sheriff; and (2) acquiring, leasing, operating and maintaining vehicles, furniture, fixtures and equipment to be utilized by the Grant Parish Sheriff's Office in carrying out its public duties?
