Village of Collinston
(Sales Tax Renewal)

Summary: 2% sales tax renewal for the Village of Collinston, to be used for any and all lawful municipal purposes.

Shall the Village of Collinston, State of Louisiana (the "Village"), under the provisions of Article VI, Section 29 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, and other constitutional and statutory authority, be authorized to continue to levy and collect a tax of two per cent (2%) (the "Tax") upon the sale at retail, the use, the lease or rental, the consumption, and the storage for use or consumption of tangible personal property and on sales of services in the Village, all as defined in La. R.S. 47:301 to 47:317, inclusive, said Tax being a renewal and consolidation of two separate one percent sales taxes that were approved at elections held in the Village on March 27 and November 20, 1999, and said renewal to be effective beginning January 1, 2010, with the proceeds of the Tax, after paying the reasonable and necessary costs and expenses of collecting and administering the Tax, to be dedicated and used for any and all lawful municipal purposes? (estimated annual revenues: \$22,000)
