Consolidated Gravity Drainage District No. 1 Proposition

Summary: Continuation of the 5.0 mills property tax within the Consolidated Gravity Drainage District No. 1 of the Parish of Tangipahoa, Louisiana, for a period of ten (10) years, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining or operating drainage works of public improvement in the Consolidated Gravity Drainage District No. 1 of the Parish of Tangipahoa, Louisiana, and implementing a comprehensive master drainage plan within the territorial limits of the Consolidated Gravity Drainage District No. 1 of the Parish of Tangipahoa, Louisiana, under the authority of Article VI, Sections 22, 30 and 32 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, as amended, and pursuant to La. R.S. 38:1902.

Shall the Consolidated Gravity Drainage District No. 1 of the Parish of Tangipahoa, Louisiana (the "District"), under the provisions of Article VI, Sections 22, 30 and 32 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, as amended (the "Louisiana Constitution"), and other constitutional and statutory authority, be authorized to continue to levy and collect, and adopt an ordinance providing for such levy and collection, of a special ad valorem tax of 5.0 mills on the dollar of assessed valuation on all property subject to taxation within the boundaries of the District (the "Tax") (an estimated \$1,750,000 is reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the Tax for an entire year), for a period of ten (10) years, commencing with the tax collection for the year 2010, and annually thereafter, to and including the tax collection for the year 2019, and shall the proceeds of said Tax (after paying the reasonable and necessary expenses of collecting and administering the Tax) be used for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining or operating drainage works of public improvement in the District, and implementing a Comprehensive Master Drainage Plan within the territorial limits of the District, under the authority of Article VI, Sections 22, 30 and 32 of the Louisiana Constitution, and pursuant to La. R.S. 38:1902?
