Village of Tickfaw Proposition

Summary: Authorizing the levy and collection of a 10.0 mills property tax within the Village of Tickfaw, for the purpose of providing fire protection to the residents of the Village of Tickfaw.

Shall the Village of Tickfaw, State of Louisiana (the "Village"), under the provisions of Article VI, Sections 30 and 32 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, as amended, and other constitutional and statutory authority, be authorized to levy and collect, and adopt an ordinance providing for such levy and collection, of a special ad valorem tax of 10.0 mills on the dollar of assessed valuation on all property subject to taxation within the boundaries of the Village (the "Tax") (an estimated \$20,650 is reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the Tax for an entire year), commencing with the tax collection for the year 2009, and annually thereafter, and shall the proceeds of such Tax (after paying the reasonable and necessary expenses of collecting and administering the Tax) be used for the purpose of providing fire protection to the residents of the Village?
