## WHAT ARE WE VOTING FOR?

This is a general election, meaning it features runoffs for any races in which no candidate won a majority of votes in last month's primary election. These will include the race for 2<sup>nd</sup> Congressional District U.S. Representative, a Court of Appeals Judge, and a Member of the Board of Elementary and Secondary Education, in addition to local and municipal races in seven parishes.

13 parishes will have elections for *parishwide propositions*, in which every registered voter in the parish is eligible to vote. Some cities, towns, and districts will also host elections for propositions limited to the voters in those areas (known as *limited jurisdiction propositions*).

## ELECT TO PLAN

**No need to wait until Election Day. You can start preparing now!**

Use the map below to know whether you might have elections in your area. Keep in mind that with the exception of parishwide propositions, most elections are limited to voters within a specified city limit or district boundary. 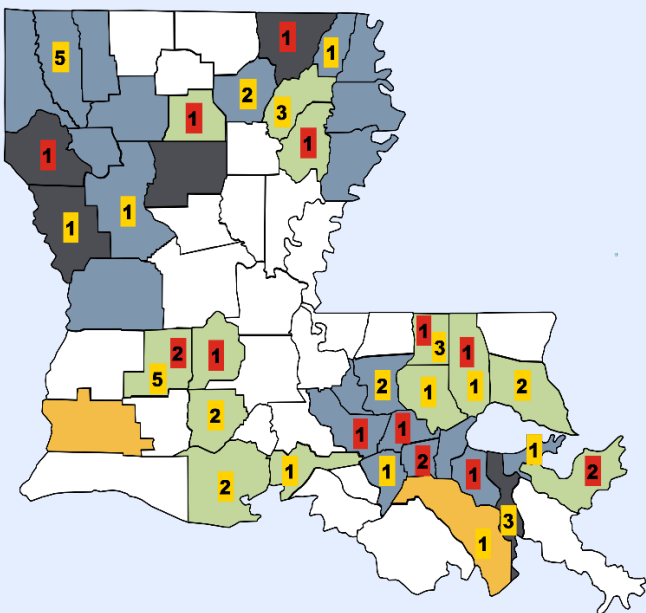

### LOUISIANA AT A GLANCE

- There are 5 parishes in which there will be candidate races for *both* state offices (such as U.S. Rep.) *and* local / municipal offices: DeSoto, Jefferson, Morehouse, Sabine, and Winn.
- There are 21 parishes in which candidate races will only include state offices (such as U.S. Rep.): Ascension, Assumption, Bienville, Bossier, Caddo, East Baton Rouge, East Carroll, Iberville, Madison, Natchitoches, Orleans, Ouachita, Red River, St. Charles, St. James, St. John, Tensas, Vernon, Webster, West Baton Rouge, and West Carroll.
- There are 2 parishes in which candidate races will only include local / municipal offices: Calcasieu and Lafourche.
- 13 parishes will have proposition elections only: Acadia, Allen, Evangeline, Franklin, Iberia, Jackson, Livingston, Richland, St. Bernard, St. Helena, St. Tammany, Tangipahoa, and Vermilion.
- 23 parishes will have no elections: Avoyelles, Beauregard, Caldwell, Cameron, Catahoula, Claiborne, Concordia, East Feliciana, Grant, Jefferson Davis, Lafayette, LaSalle, Lincoln, Plaquemines, Pointe Coupee, Rapides, St. Landry, St. Martin, St. Mary, Terrebonne, Union, Washington, and West Feliciana.

\*Note: Parishes with a non-green color fill **and** a number will have candidate races as well as propositions.
