- C. Each person wanting to speak must fill out a request slip (Attachment #2).
 - 1. If you have not already done so, please fill out a slip now.
 - 2. If you need a slip, please raise your hand and a slip will be provided to you.

D. Limitation on Time

- 1. Speakers will be limited to 10 minutes, unless the presiding officer determines that the time needs to be reduced or increased. Time will be reduced if the speaker is merely repeating what he has already said. Time will be increased if the comments are productive and are not repetitive.
 - 2. A speaker is to state:
 - a. whether he or she is for or against the amendments being proposed;
 - b. specific provisions being commented on;
 - c. the specific reasons for the speaker's position; and/or
 - d. any recommendations by the speaker regarding the amendments.
 - 3. A speaker who starts to repeat himself or herself will be asked to move on to any other comments.
- 4. A speaker who merely states that he or she is against the proposed amendments or any part of the amendments but does not provide specific reasons may be asked to provide further information as provided for in item 2.
- E. Discussion of matters unrelated to the proposed amendments will not be allowed or considered.
- F. No response to the comments or submissions will be made today. All comments and submissions will be fully considered before any response is provided.
