**URBAN MEYER TO VISIT EDDIE G. ROBINSON MUSEUM**  
**AS PART OF LEGACY KEEPERS SERIES**

**BATON ROUGE, La.**—Secretary of State Kyle Ardoin is inviting the public to attend the inaugural event of “Legacy Keepers: Preserving the Eddie Robinson Playbook” on Thursday, March 21 at 7 p.m. at the Fredrick C. Hobdy Assembly Center on the campus of Grambling State University. Former Ohio State University head football coach Urban Meyer will serve as the event’s keynote speaker continuing the celebration of Coach Eddie G. Robinson’s 100<sup>th</sup> birthday. Admission for the event is free, and doors open at 6 p.m.
