ABSENTEE BALLOT DEADLINES FOR THE APRIL 27 MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION

BATON ROUGE, La. — Secretary of State Nancy Landry reminds voters of the upcoming absentee ballot deadlines for the April 27 Municipal General Election.

The deadline to **request** an absentee ballot is **Tuesday, April 23 by 4:30 p.m.** Requests can be made online by visiting voterportal.sos.la.gov and selecting “Request Absentee Ballot,” or in person at the parish Registrar of Voters office. Voters who have requested but not yet received an absentee ballot may check their absentee ballot status by visiting voterportal.sos.la.gov, entering the appropriate voter information and selecting “Check Absentee Ballot Status.”

The deadline to **return** a completed ballot is **Friday, April 26 by 4:30 pm.** Completed ballots can be returned to the parish Registrar of Voters by mail, in-person by the voter, or by a voter’s immediate family member. Should a voter be unable to meet an absentee ballot deadline, they can still vote in-person on Election Day. Polling locations can also be found on voterportal.sos.la.gov or on the free GeauxVote mobile app.
