BATON ROUGE, La. — Qualifying for the Oct. 11, 2025 Open Primary/Orleans Municipal Parochial Primary Election will take place Wednesday, July 9 through Friday, July 11.

All local candidates must qualify with their parish Clerk of Court. Candidates may qualify for office by paying a qualifying fee or filing a nominating petition and are encouraged to check with their local Clerk of Court for specific parish hours. More information, including contact information for parish Clerk of Court Offices, can be found by visiting GeauxVote.com and selecting the Election Qualifying link. Once qualified, candidates will appear on the Secretary of State's website at <u>www.sos.la.gov</u>.

Pursuant to Louisiana Revised Statutes <u>18:461</u> and <u>18:463</u>, qualifying candidates will be required to provide an email address and present a valid Louisiana driver's license or Louisiana identification card. The email address provided will be listed on the Secretary of State's website.
