LAST DAY TO EARLY VOTE, SATURDAY, OCT. 17TH

Secretary of State Tom Schedler reminds all Louisianians eligible to vote in the Saturday, October 24, 2015 Gubernatorial Primary Election that the last day to early vote is SATURDAY, OCTOBER 17TH. Early voting locations are open from 8:30 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Citizens who want to vote early may do so in person at their parish Registrar of Voters Office or at other designated locations. For a complete listing of early voting locations visit: <https://voterportal.sos.la.gov/EarlyVoting>.

“Early voting has been steady during the past week,” said Secretary of State Tom Schedler. “Our numbers indicate slightly less participation than we saw during the 2014 Congressional Elections which resulted in a 50% statewide turnout. The Gubernatorial Elections next Saturday could see anywhere from 40-50% turnout if history is any indication.”

Voters should utilize Louisiana’s award winning smartphone application, GeauxVote Mobile, to find out where to vote, what’s on their ballot and their voting districts. Statewide, there are more than 1,000 candidate races including all statewide elected officials and legislators. Additionally, there are four statewide constitutional amendments voters will be asked to decide as well as 73 propositions in 27 parishes.
