Job Description:

Are You?

- Election Day Worker only on Election Day
 Earn up to \$200
 - Arrive at least 30 minutes 1 hour before polls opening
 - Able to work for the entire day (6:00 am 8:00 pm)
- Early Voting Worker 10 days excluding Sundays
- Earn \$100 per day
- Arrive at least 30 minutes prior to polls opening
- Able to work from 8:00 am 7:00 pm
- Absentee Worker Board of Election Supervisors meeting days
 - Earn \$50 per meeting
 - You will be notified about the time of meeting but expect to work at least 4 hours

Remember ...

- > You must provide your own transportation to the assigned precinct.
- You must remain at your assigned location all day, you are unable to leave the precinct during your shift.
- Personal Protective Equipment will be provided for you.
